

Policy regarding the Personal Data Act

On 2 June 2014, the Swedish Fundraising Control has adopted the following policy for the handling of personal data.

Project

The purpose of storing personal data is to administer control of the 90-account holders in a secure and effective manner.

Reason

The reason for registration is to be able to submit or obtain information regarding representatives of the 90-account holder or their auditor as part of the work of checking compliance with the Swedish Fundraising Control's standards. This information is only used for internal purposes.

Information that is saved

The information that is registered in the system comprises the civic registration number, name, address, telephone number and e-mail address of the 90-account holder's Board members, deputies, representatives/contact people, signatories and auditors.

How registered individuals are notified

Registered individuals may study the information in this document when they provide details in the application for a 90-account, in amendment requests and in applications for an extended validity period. New auditors receive information when they are approved as account auditors.

The registered person is entitled to receive information indicating which details are registered about him or her. Amendments to the information can be made on request by the registered person. The personal data is not given out to anyone else, see the Swedish Fundraising Control's confidentiality policy.
